APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Applicants MUST be a US citizen to apply for the VASNHS Dietetic Internship
- Males MUST have registered for selective service or be exempt to be eligible to apply to this program
- A minimum cumulative and DPD GPA of 3.0
- Completion of all requirements for the DPD from a program accredited by the Accreditation Council for Education in Nutrition and Dietetics (ACEND) of the Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics must be completed within the past three (3) years
- Track 1 (non-degree): Earned master's degree granted by a U.S. accredited or Foreign Dietitian Education program (FDE) by program start date
- Track 2: Admission to Rutgers MS in Clinical Nutrition Program and selection of VASNHS as dietetic internship site
