GENERAL INFORMATION

- All programs are accredited by the Accreditation Council for Education in Nutrition and Dietetics (ACEND) and participate in the Spring application cycle through DICAS and the Spring match via D&D Digital.
- There are <u>no additional application fees</u> to apply to any of the VA programs.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

- United States citizenship at the time of application to qualify for stipend
- Registered for selective service (males)
- Minimum GPAs vary with programs. Range from 3.0 3.3
- Strong reading ability and solid written and verbal communication skills
- Well-developed organizational and time management skills
- Ability to works well independently AND on teams
- Enjoy learning and working in a fast-paced environment
- Prefer working with adults
- Fluency in reading, writing and speaking in English
 - Fluency in both English and Spanish for Puerto Rico internship



VA INTERNSHIP BENEFITS

- Stipend provided (at most VA-sponsored programs)

Admission Requirements:

- Applicants must have a DPD Verification Statement from an ACEND accredited program and MS in Nutrition or other related field with proof of completion before internship start date August 2024

MS + Internship Option (16-month)

- Interns must apply to Texas Woman's University (TWU) graduate school for MS-Nutrition
- 50-week supervised practice (12 months)
- Final semester will be focused on Masters completion
- Applicants must have a DPD Verification Statement from ACEND accredited program





SELECTION PROCESS REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum GPA requirement (varies with program from 3.0 to 3.3)
- Strong letters of recommendation (3)
- Dietetics-related experiences are helpful includes paid and volunteer clinical, food service
- Personal Statement/letter
 - Be insightful & honest about yourself. Make your statement unique to you.
 - Explain how your professional goals MATCH with what we can provide (i.e., WHY do you want to attend this specific program?)
 - Letter should be customized to each program you're applying to.
- Recency of education requirement:
 - DPD Verification Statement and MNT courses must be within past 3 years
- Know which programs conduct interviews and which are application only
 - Be prepared to interview!
 - Be prepared to provide writing samples.
